

## You could be eligible for assistance on your local phone service.

Your telephone company encourages eligible low income residential customers to take advantage of available discounts on their telephone bills. The **Lifeline program** provides customers with limited incomes a discount of \$11.25 per month (up to \$12.35 for customers age 65 or older) on basic as well as more advanced combinations of services.

You may qualify for **Lifeline** if your household income is at or below 150% of the federal poverty level. You may also qualify if you participate in one of the following assistance programs:

- Medicaid
- Food Stamps
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance (LIHEAP)
- National School Lunch Program
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

Regulations established by the Federal Communications Commission prohibit any household from receiving more than one Lifeline discount and Lifeline customers will be asked to verify their continued eligibility for the program on a regular basis.
